

## Dining for Dollars Host Frequently Asked Questions

1. **How many people can I expect?** As many as you can comfortably accommodate for your type of event. Please plan for at least 6.
2. **What time will they arrive and how late will they stay?** The start and end time of the event is up to you.
3. **Are children allowed?** It's your decision. If you host an event where children are welcome, please include it in your event description.
4. **Where shall I feed people-inside or out?** Wherever you are most comfortable hosting your friends.
5. **Should I pick a theme for the evening?** If that sounds fun to you and makes sense to plan the menu. Themed events tend to be most popular.
6. **Do I have to cook it myself or can I order in?** Host as you would for your friends. You can cook or call a restaurant if that better suits your schedule.
7. **Who will pay for the food and drinks?** You. Since this is a fundraiser event, you are asked to donate the items and your contribution is tax deductible. You can submit your receipts to the IRS.
8. **Do I get to choose who comes to my home?** No. Guests are determined by the highest bids. Encourage your friends to bid on your event.
9. **Should I be concerned with dietary restrictions?** Not necessarily. It is helpful to list the complete menu in the event description and if you will offer any meat, wheat, or dairy-free options.
